As the principal contractor, Cardno completed a major remediation program in a coastal part of regional Victoria and next to a major industrial facility. They removed subsurface hydrocarbon contamination from the protected foreshore area. Cardno's robust, innovative, and cost-effective solutions have resulted in 70,000 m3 (2,472,026 cubic feet) of contaminated soil being excavated and remediated onsite, most of which has been treated using the sand washing plant, with lesser impacted soils treated via biopiling.

Cardno's 130-acre (52.6 hectare) native plant nursery is one of the largest in the Midwest, offering native plants and seeds, and bioengineering materials needed for successful restoration, mitigation, and native landscape projects.

Its materials fulfill a range of project needs from wetland and prairie seed mixes to the deep-rooted native plants critical for shoreline stabilization and erosion control.

This nursery offers more than 350 native plant species in a variety of options to quickly create native habitats and stabilize project sites. This team can also perform contract growing and provide customized seed mixes as well as natural coir bioengineering materials that can be prevegetated with appropriate native species.
